Machine Planting is \$23.00 per 100 feet. The minimum planting is 300 feet per site. A 50% down payment is required at the time trees are ordered. There may be several cost share programs available. Please stop by the office for more information.

Fabric Installation is \$.58 per foot. Includes fabric, installation and 1 helper to pull trees through fabric. Staples are not included and will be applied by the producer, unless otherwise arranged with the district. (Labor charges will apply).

Hand plants are \$34.00 for bundles of 25 (same species) or \$2.00 for individual trees. 1 or 2 year windbreak replacement trees \$1.00 each. Contact the office for specialty trees, pricing subject to order.

Payment is expected in full for hand plants at the time order is placed.

THE FALL RIVER CONSERVATION DISTRICT TREE POLICY WILL STAND AS SUCH:

Replacement of trees only if nursery stock is proven faulty and nursery is willing to replace stock at their cost.

The District is not responsible for any and all trees once they leave the District possession; and is not responsible for the replanting on trees.

Machine planting: A 50 % deposit is required at the time the order is placed and the balance is due 30 days after planting. After 30 days interest of 1.5% will be charged per month. **Hand plants:** will require payment in full at the time the order is placed. **The district will not be responsible for the condition of tree stock if they are not picked up from tree cooler within the allotted time.**

Tree Packs – (25 trees/pack, 5 of each species)

Packs may change according to year

Grandma's Jam Pack –

Make loads of luscious jams and jellies from wild fruit, just like Grandma did when you were a kid! Picking the wild fruit can also be an exciting adventure for families with small children. Depending on weather conditions, many of the plants will produce fruit annually. One pack plants an entire orchard! **Pack contains:** Buffalo berry, Nanking Cherry, Schubert Chokecherry, Sand Cherry, and Prairie Red Plum.

Fast Pack – Hearty trees, easily adaptable to most soils, fast growing. **Pack contains:** Black Chokeberry, Amur Chokecherry, Male Cottonwood, Redosier Dogwood, and Laurel Leaf Willow.

Tough-as-Nails Pack – With the exception of saturated soils, these hardy plants will grow just about anywhere in South Dakota! The trees and shrubs offered in this pack are native to the harsh environment of the upper Midwest or introduced from even tougher climates in Asia. The trees in this are a sure bet! **Pack contains:** Buffalo berry, Caragana, Honey locust, Burr Oak, Russian Olive.

Wildlife Pack – The trees and shrubs offered in the **Wildlife** pack provide food, nesting sites, and cover for songbirds, small animals and wild game. Plant several wildlife packs and start your own wildlife sanctuary! **Pack contains:** Pin Cherry, American Hazelnut, Burr Oak, Hansen Hedge rose, Skunk bush Sumac.

Tree Crystals

*** ONE POUND OF CRYSTALS WILL DO 75 TO 100 TREES.

*** USE ABOUT 1 PINT OF HYDRATED CRYSTALS, 1/2 to 3/4 of a cup. (already absorbed the water) PER TREE. PUT CRYSTALS IN HOLE FIRST, THEN TREE.

***3 – 5 OUNCES OF CRYSTALS WILL FILL A 5 GALLON BUCKET, DEPENDING ON THE HARDNESS AND SALT IN YOUR WATER. IT TAKES 24–48 HOURS FOR CRYSTALS TO ABSORB WATER. WARM WATER WILL SPEED UP PROCESS.
