

The Lincoln Conservation District has provided low-cost trees and shrubs for sale to the public at its Annual Tree & Shrub Seedling Sale. This is a great opportunity for landowners to join with the District in "putting conservation in the ground". The plants are suitable for use in a variety of locations, including your urban backyard and along your streamside property to establish a lush riparian buffer.

More than 30 plant species are available, including many plants that are native to the region. The plants are **small, bare-root seedlings typically 12 to 24 inches tall.**

The order period begins in August each year, with plants available for pick up in the spring. Early ordering of plants is encouraged, as supplies are limited and orders are filled in the order they are received. Any surplus trees and shrubs will be available for purchase after the district is done machine planting.

In October or later, a newsletter will have the availability of plants and ordering instructions will be available.
